With the goal of providing students with the highest quality learning experience, GSC has established policies and procedures to ensure that the students' experience is consistent across all courses and supports faculty in their continuous development. All faculty are expected to be familiar with and adhere to established GSC policies and procedures in the [GSC Faculty Handbook](#). In addition, faculty are required to become conversant with teaching expectations and course requirements as outlined in this document. The assessment and refinement of high quality education offerings at GSC are informed through direct and indirect means during several phases:

- course construction
- teaching and implementation, and
- post hoc evaluation

GSC's Academic Affairs administration works in concert with faculty to provide students with the most optimal learning environment. High levels of engagement, inquiry, and reflection are at the core of the model for continual enhancement of quality teaching practice. These items are informed through multiple data points.
