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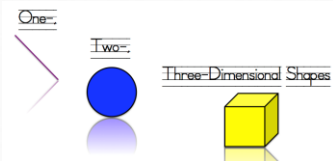

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

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

- Just save it to your desktop(I recommend creating a folder to house your narrations for quick access to upload)



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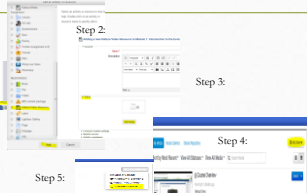
